Responsibilities:

- Wash, dry, fold and organize laundry
- Clean windows and window ledges
- Sweep and mop floors
- Wash, sanitize and organize dishes
- Sanitize, scrub and rinse animal carriers
- Restock rooms with laundry and cleaning supplies
- Assist with any other cleaning needs the ARL may have at any given time

Requirements:

- Must be able to bend, squat, kneel and stand for prolonged periods of time
- Must be comfortable with being on your feet and moving around for prolonged periods of time

Training:

- No training is required, as we will start your first shift with an overview of our processes and readily have staff available to assist with questions.
