Why volunteer as a Cat Kennel Cleaning Assistant?

Are you a cool cat that wants to make a difference with ARL's homeless felines? If so, volunteering as a Cat Kennel Cleaning Assistant might be the purrfect fit! We are looking for dedicated volunteers to help provide a clean and comfortable place for our feline friends to rest, while they wait for their furever homes.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide fresh food and water for the cats
- Sanitize, scrub, and rinse cat kennels
- Work alongside Animal Care Technicians to help with cat care
- Make and give out enrichment
- Stay up to date on current ARL processes, procedures and handling policies
- Restock cat rooms

Requirements

- Must be able to lift up to 30lbs
- Must be able to bend, squat, kneel and stand for prolonged periods of time
- Must be comfortable with being on your feet and moving around for prolonged periods of time
- Must be able to climb up and down a ladder

Shifts

- Volunteers must sign up for shifts a minimum of 12 hours in advance
- Shift times:
 - Monday – Friday: 7-9am, 9-11am, 1-3pm, 5-7pm
 - Saturday – Sunday: 7-9am, 9-11am, 1-3pm, 4-6pm

Trainings

- Volunteers will sign up for a training shift, where they will receive on the job training
- Training shift times:
 - Every Wednesday: 8-10am
