## Why volunteer as a Transport Trooper?

Transport Troopers are responsible for transporting a variety of pets to and from the ARL and its local partnering organizations. Without Transport Troopers, we would not be able to help nearly as many pets as we do!

## Duties and Responsibilities

- Check-in and gather daily schedule
- Travel to the various daily locations to pick up and drop off animals
- Upon completion of shift, perform check-out duties
- Positively represent the ARL at all partnering organizations

## Requirements

- Must have a valid driver's license
- Must be able to operate ARL transportation vehicles
- Must be able to interact with dogs, cats and small animals
- Must be able to lift up to 30lbs

## Shift Hours

- Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 11am – 2pm
- Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 12:30-2:30pm

## Training

- Volunteers will complete multiple ride-along shifts with a staff member or experienced volunteer
