- Work alongside Customer Experience Technicians to practice ARL's customer-focused adoption process.
- Assist in the adoption process, which includes accurately entering
 essential information into ARL's database, processing payments,
 promoting retail sales at Animal House, discussing pet health insurance
 and microchip details, and reviewing medical records and ARL's
 adoption contract with potential adopters.

Training

- Volunteers will shadow a Customer Experience Technician until they are ready to complete the adoption process on their own.
- Ongoing training will be provided as needed.
