

Procedure for Becoming an ARL TheraPets Team

1. Application

a. All prospective volunteers will submit program-specific application.

2. Attend ARL TheraPets Training Workshop (without animal)

a. Responsibilities of an ARL TheraPets volunteer, definitions related to and benefits of Animal Assisted Interventions (AAI), qualities needed to succeed, HIPAA/ confidentiality, infection control, working with different populations, patient approach, therapy animal's well-being and more. Plus a review of the TheraPets Team Assessment.

3. Observe a Visit (optional)

4. Pet Health Screening Form

- a. This form can be completed from pet's medical record, at the discretion of the pet's Veterinarian.
- b. If the pet is due for any vaccinations/testing, these must be updated *prior to* their TheraPets Teams Assessment, at the volunteer's expense. Failure to do so can result in the assessment being canceled.

5. The TheraPets Team Assessment

a. An assessment of the potential TheraPets Team is performed by the Program Coordinator and ARL's Pet Behavior department. After completion, the Program Coordinator will review score and next steps.

6. Select a Facility (after passing Team Assessment)

- a. The volunteer selects a facility from the TheraPets Partners list and contacts them directly to schedule their first and subsequent visits.
 - i. Depending on past experience, the team may be accompanied on their first visit by the program coordinator or other experienced TheraPets volunteer.

Current/Past Members of Other Therapy Animal Organizations

Some potential volunteers may have/had therapy animal certification or registration with another organization. In order to become an ARL TheraPets Team, all volunteers must complete our process as outlined above.
